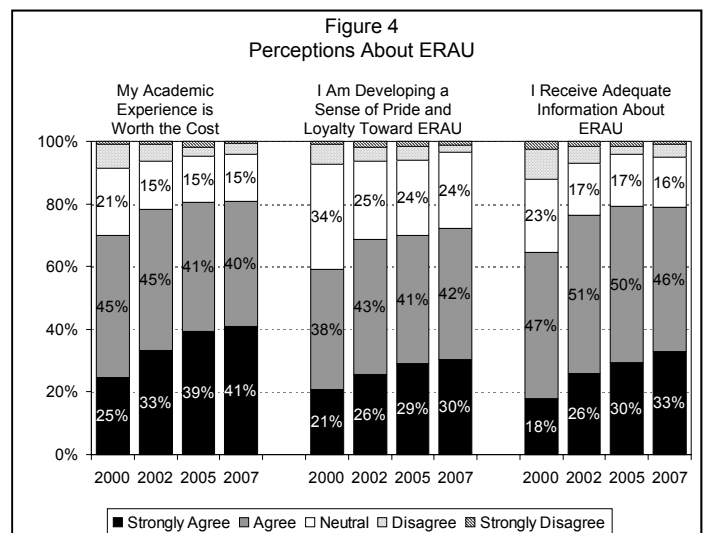
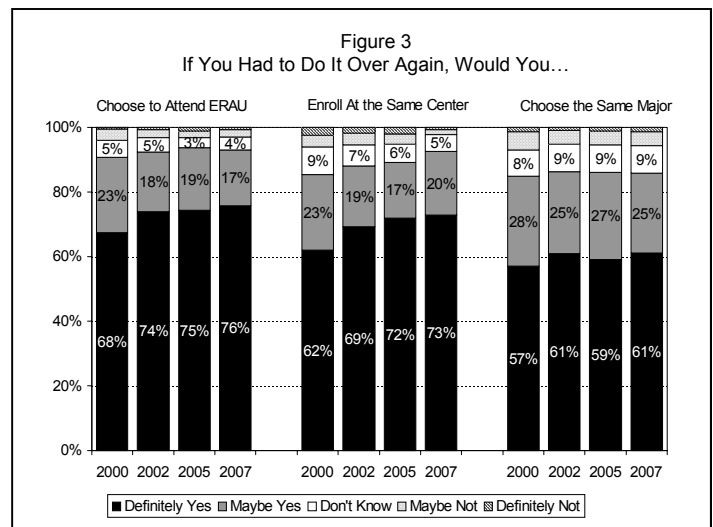
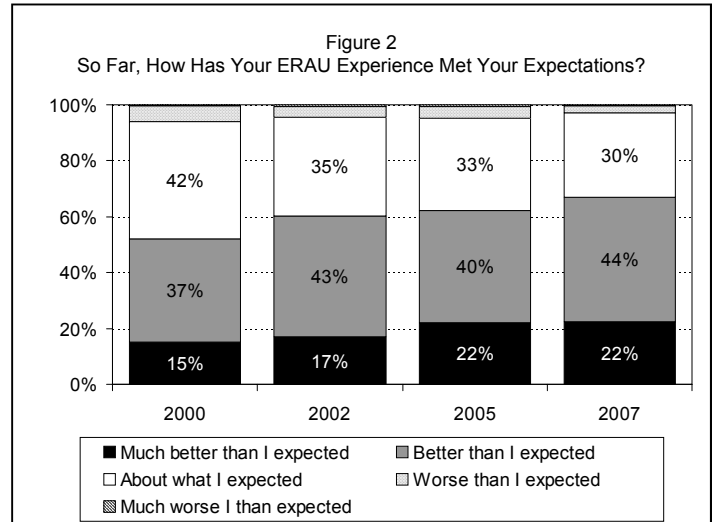
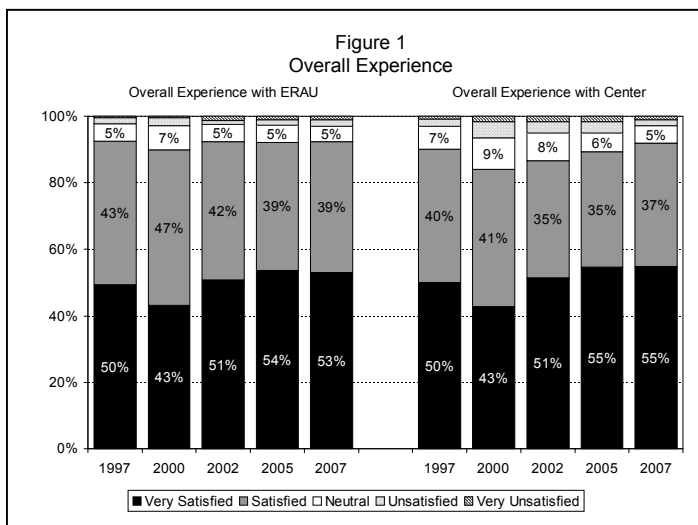
The ERAU Worldwide Student Satisfaction Survey was developed to assess the level of satisfaction of students enrolled at the various domestic and international centers of Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University - Worldwide. The in-house instrument includes questions regarding reasons for attending ERAU, overall experience with the university and the center attended, and perceptions of academic programs, instruction and student services.

The Office of Institutional Research administered the 2007 Worldwide Student Satisfaction Survey to a stratified random sample of the 7,599 students enrolled in the Spring 2007 term at ERAU Worldwide. A combination of proportionate and disproportionate sampling was used to ensure an adequate number of responses from each center.

2,000 surveys were mailed out, and of 1,875 deliverable surveys, 665 (35%) were completed and returned.

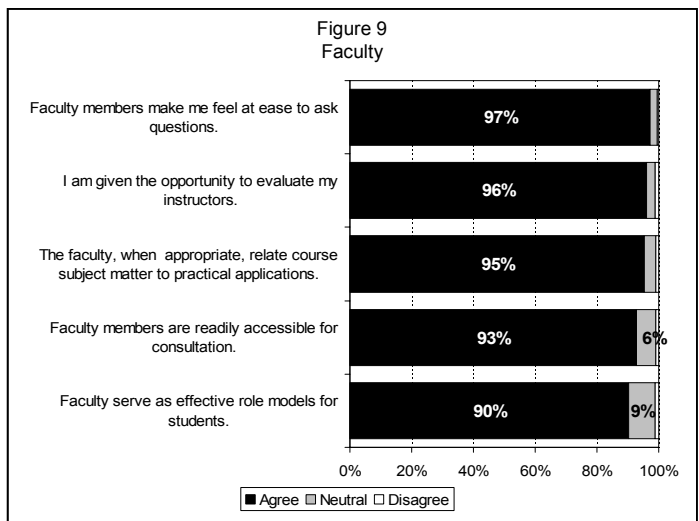
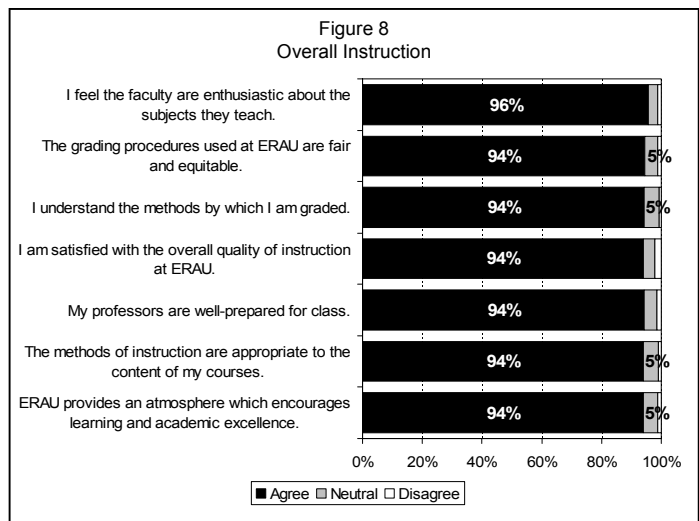
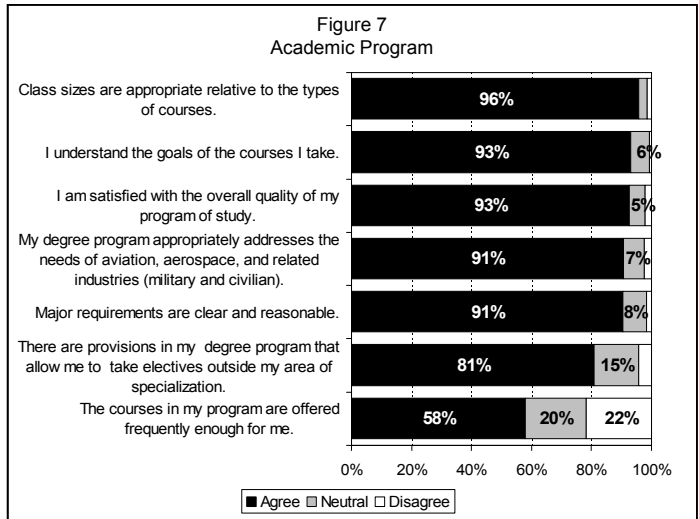
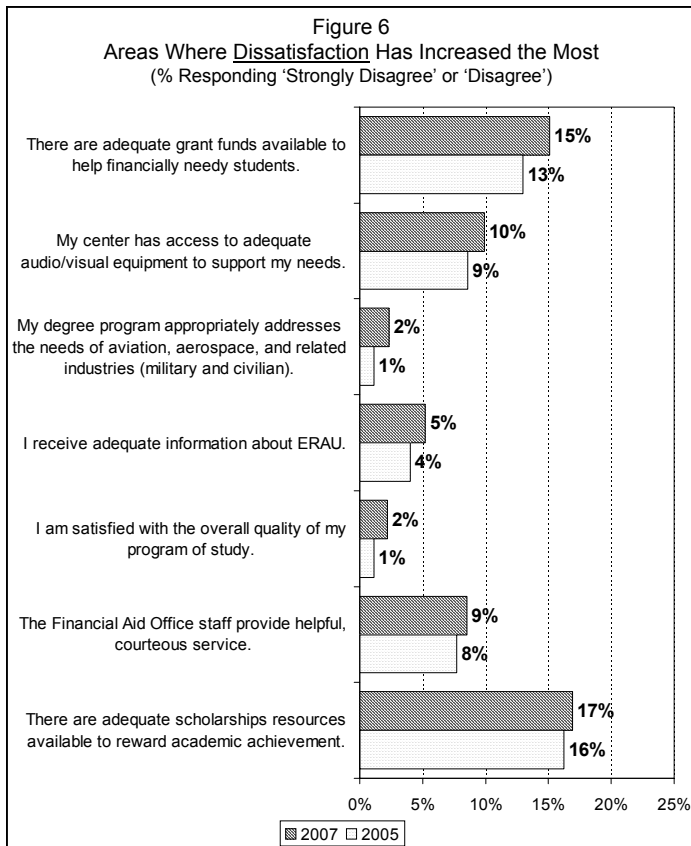
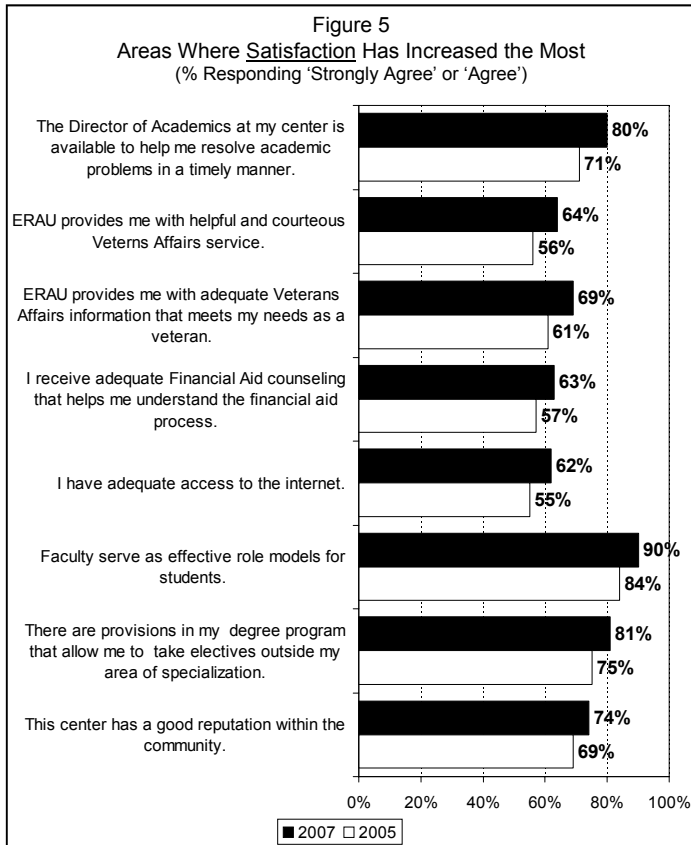
This issue of the IR Preview summarizes findings for all centers combined, and where appropriate it compares the results to data from previous administrations.

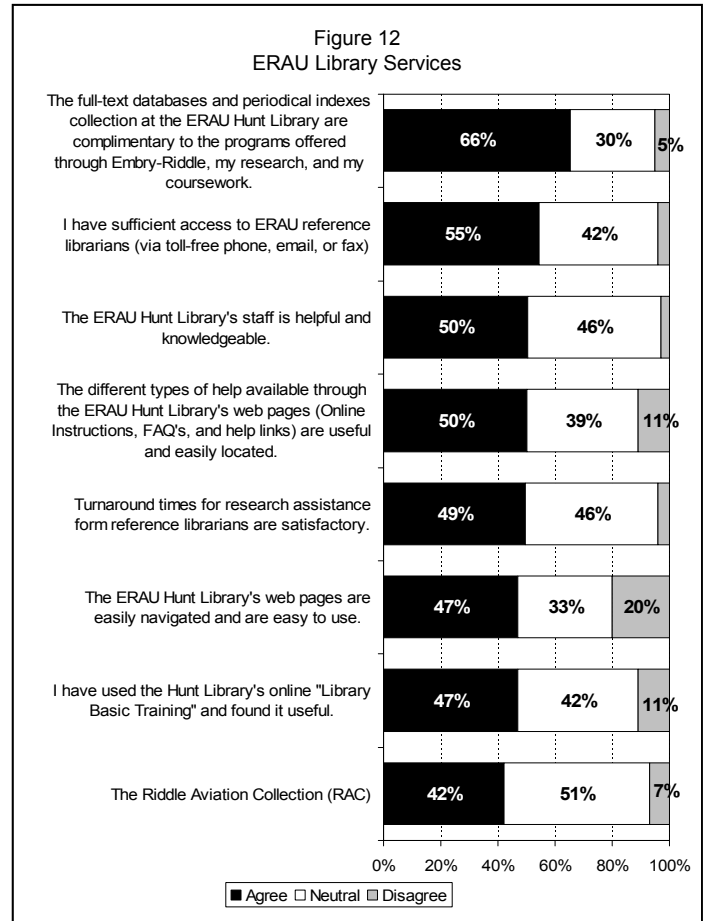
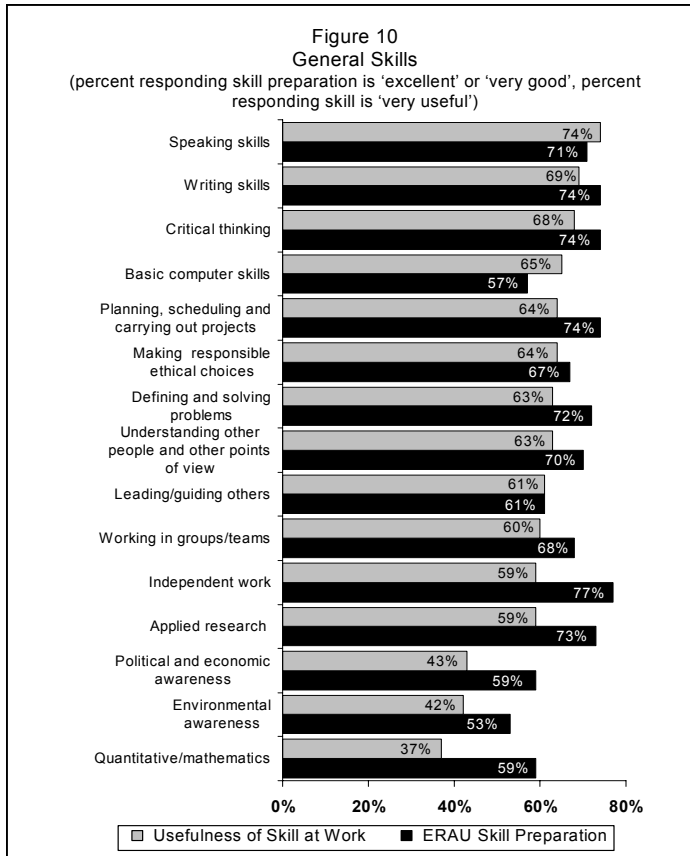
◆ Overall Satisfaction



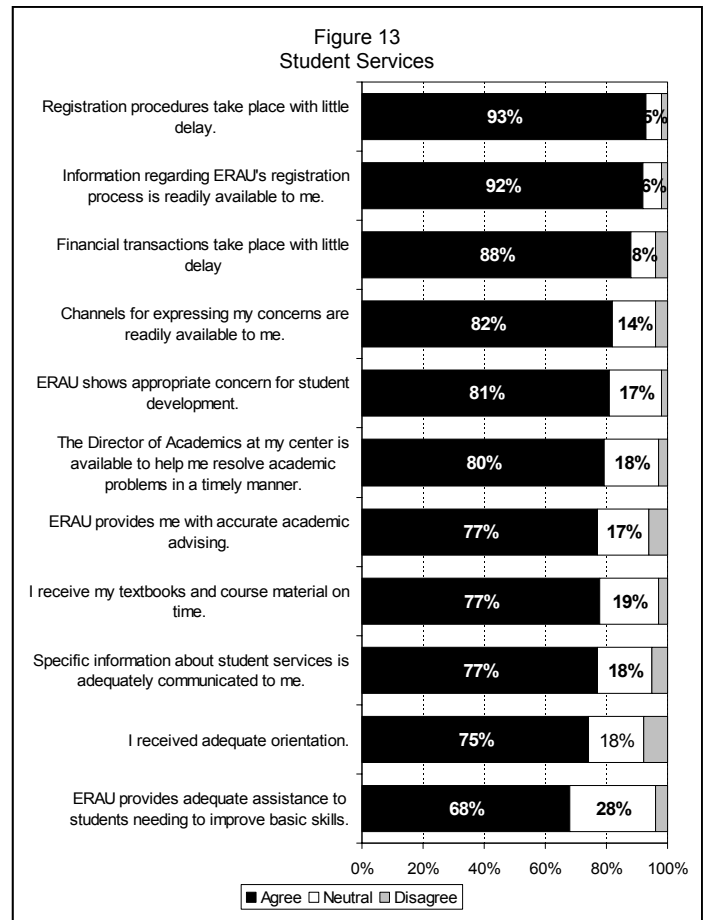
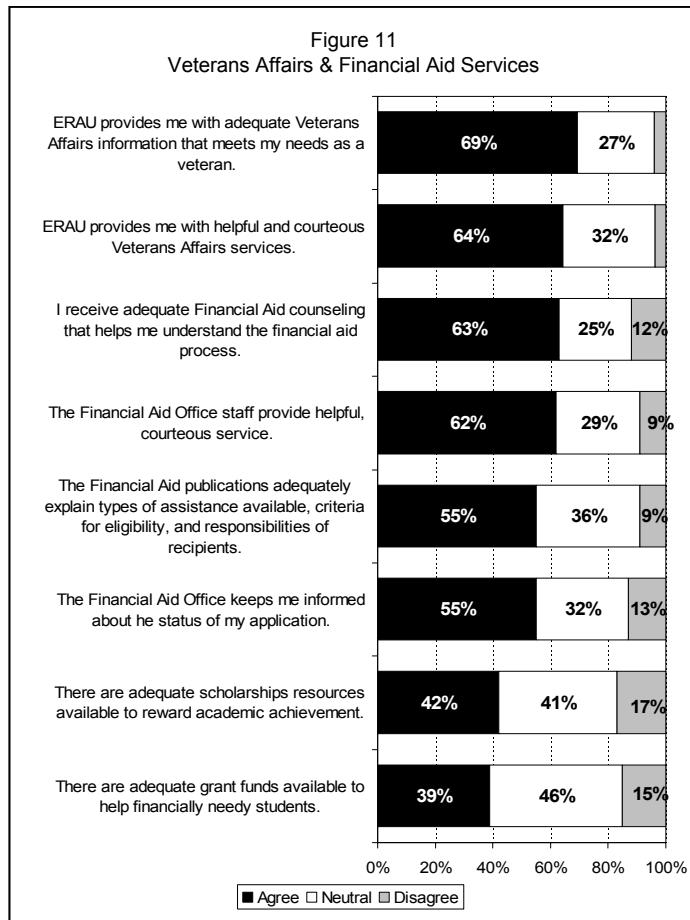
◆ Trend Analysis: Most Notable Changes 2005 to 2008

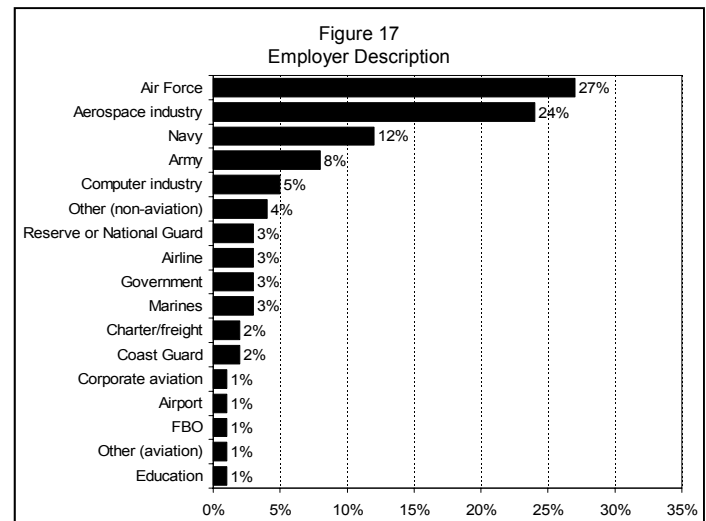
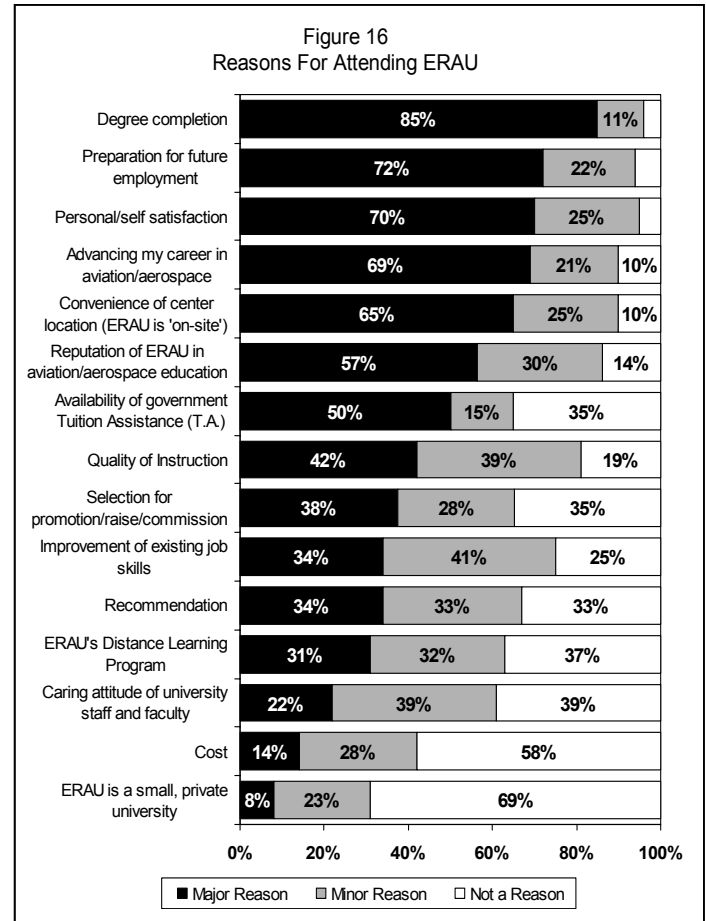
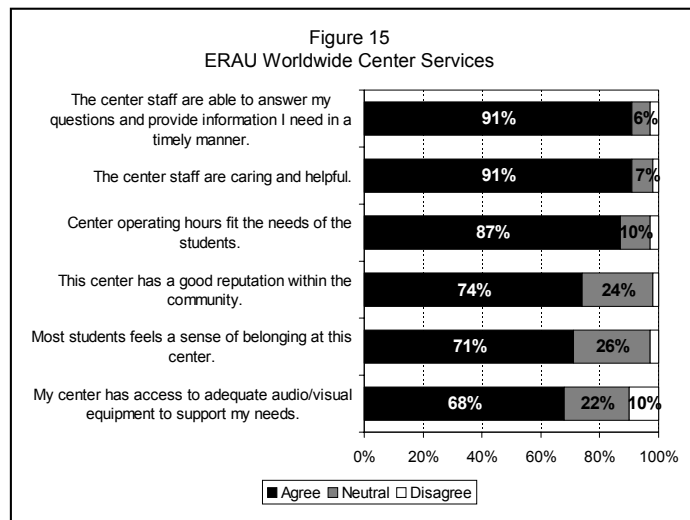
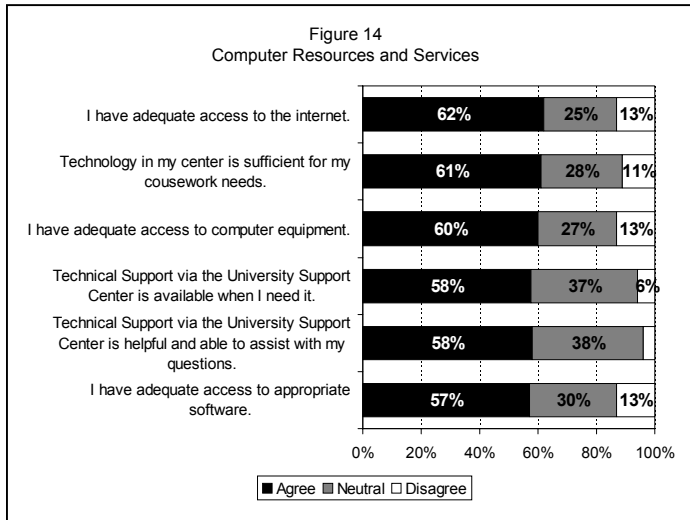
